GENERAL RECOMMENDATIONS

PARKLAND AND NATURAL ENVIRONMENT

- Provide connectivity of tree canopy through the entire area to enhance habitat for native species.
- Provide planting of native shade trees along the Wagirra trail.
- Enhance biodiversity values and vegetation connectivity through the area.
- Resolve drainage issues from the Riverina Highway
- Identify opportunities for additional shade planting in activated areas.

LIGHTING DESIGN

Improve lighting to areas with high activity.

STRUCTURES ON LAKE HUME

- Liaise with NSW and VIC authorities regarding requirements for boat prohibited zones.
- There are commercial opportunities for water activities such as: floating pontoons, inflatable water fun parks, canoes, water bikes, and paddle board hire.
- Investigate temporary mooring of water craft.

- Improve wayfinding and interpretive signage to key
- Liaise with Transport for NSW to provide wayfinding signage from Riverina Highway to key areas.
- Provide indicative signage for the closest public
- Improve signage for traffic inside the reserve (boat ramps, parking, and accessibility)
- Improve safety signage for water activities.
- Provide educational signage in the natural reserve

- Review maintenance program for all areas.
- Discuss longer term maintenance requirements for the Lake Hume Beach area with Lessee.

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

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RECOMMENDATIONS

LAKE HUME BEACH AREA

a. VEHICLE ACCESS AND CAR PARKING

- a1. Provide new asphalt loop car parking on the upgraded access road (25 car spaces approx).
- a2. Demolish the existing car parking area and replace
- a3. Implement Water Sensitive Urban Design principles in car park areas.
- a4. Improve entry signage to public area.

b. PEDESTRIAN AND BIKE ACCESS

- b1. Provide a 2.5 m wide staircase from the Lake Hume Boat Ramp car park to the beach area.
- b2. Provide a staircase and investigate a DDA compliant ramp from the grass to the sand under the 100% water line of the beach.
- b3. WAGIRRA TRAIL Provide a 2.5m wide, shared pathway to create a recreational connection along the lakeside. The paths should include connections to lookouts, vistas, picnic areas, water access points and car parks from the dam wall to the Bethanga Bridge.
- b4. Investigate the feasibility of improving access from the 100% capacity level to the 50% capacity level.
- b5. No public access past this point.

c. BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

- c1. Provide BBQ.
- c2. Provide new public amenities.
- c3. Provide larger sheltered structure that can facilitate potential commercial activities.
- c4. Provide a retaining-seating wall on the 100% water
- c5. WAGIRRA TRAIL Provide shelters and seating
- c6. Demolish old amenities block when new toilets are

d1. Provide removable bollards for maintenance and emergency access to the beach.

e. ACTIVITIES

e1. Provide additional recreational activities including a district level nature-based play space.

LAKE HUME BOAT RAMP AREA

a. VEHICLE ACCESS AND CAR PARKING

- a1. Linemark and investigate tree planting opportunities. (Existing car park - 75 car spaces and 50 trailer spaces).
- a2. Investigate new access road linking the car park to
- a3. Implement Water sensitive urban design principles in car park areas.
- a4. Improve entry signage to public area.

b. PEDESTRIAN AND BIKE ACCESS

- b1. Provide a 2.5 m wide staircase from the Lake Hume Boat Ramp car park to the beach area.
- b2. WAGIRRA TRAIL Provide a 2.5m wide, shared pathway to create a recreational connection along the lakeside. The paths should include connections to lookouts, vistas, picnic areas, water access points and car parks from the dam wall to the Bethanga Bridge.

e1. Liaise with Lake Hume Resort Owners to reactivate outdoor mini golf, basketball court and tennis court.



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RECOMMENDATIONS

APEX PARK BOAT RAMP AREA

a. VEHICLE ACCESS AND CAR PARKING

- a1. Extend boat ramp to access water at 30% capacity
- a2. Upgrade the boat ramp with turning circles and waiting lines suitable for larger boats.
- a3. Provide a new car park for cars and boat trailers.
- a4. Short term resurface existing road.
- Long term investigate alternative alignment of
- a5. Implement Water sensitive urban design principles in car park areas.
- a6. Improve entry signage to public area.

b. PEDESTRIAN AND BIKE ACCESS

- b1. WAGIRRA TRAIL Provide a 2.5m wide, shared pathway to create a recreational connection along the lakeside. The paths should include connections to lookouts, vistas, picnic areas, water access points and car parks from the dam to the Bethanga Bridge.
- b2. Improve interface between 100% water level and parkland with revetment works and controlled access

BETHANGA BRIDGE REST AREA

a. VEHICLE ACCESS AND CAR PARKING

a1. Investigate opportunities to create a car park at Bethanga Bridge turning point area.

a2. Implement Water sensitive urban design principles

a3. Improve entry signage to public area.

b. PEDESTRIAN AND BIKE ACCESS

b1. WAGIRRA TRAIL - Provide a 2.5m wide, shared pathway to create a recreational connection along the lakeside. The paths should include connections to lookouts, vistas, picnic areas, water access points and car parks from the dam to the Bethanga Bridge.

b2. Provide a pedestrian/cycle link across the Bethanga Bridge that would connect the Victorian Trail network. This connection would be an integral element to create a Lake Hume Trail loop which could link Lake Hume Village, Bethanga, Tallangatta and Wodonga.

b3. Improve interface between 100% water level and parkland with revetment works and controlled access

b4. WAGIRRA TRAIL - Investigate opportunities to run a trail under the bridge, to avoid crossing the Riverina

b5. Investigate recreational trail linking Lake Hume Reserves to Bowna and Table Top along the 100%

c. BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

c1. Investigate opportunities for building a scenic lookout with shelters and feature seating at the Bethanga Bridge.

c2. platform seats and tree planting next to the 100%

BELOW WEIR WALL PARKLAND

a. VEHICLE ACCESS AND CAR PARKING

- a1. Implement water sensitive urban design principles in car park areas.
- a2. Improve entry signage to public area.

b. PEDESTRIAN AND BIKE ACCESS

- b1. Improve interface between 100% water level and parkland with revetment works and controlled access
- b2. Investigate non-powered vessel launching area
- b3. Provide a 2.5m wide pathway to create a connection along the river.
- b4. Liaise with local land service for maintenance and upkeep of traveling stock reserve (TSR).

c. BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

- c1. Provide picnic shelters, tables and feature seating
- c2. Investigate opportunities to improve access for fishing e.g. Fishing platform.

d. FENCING

d1. Provide removable bollards for maintenance and emergency access to the parkland.
